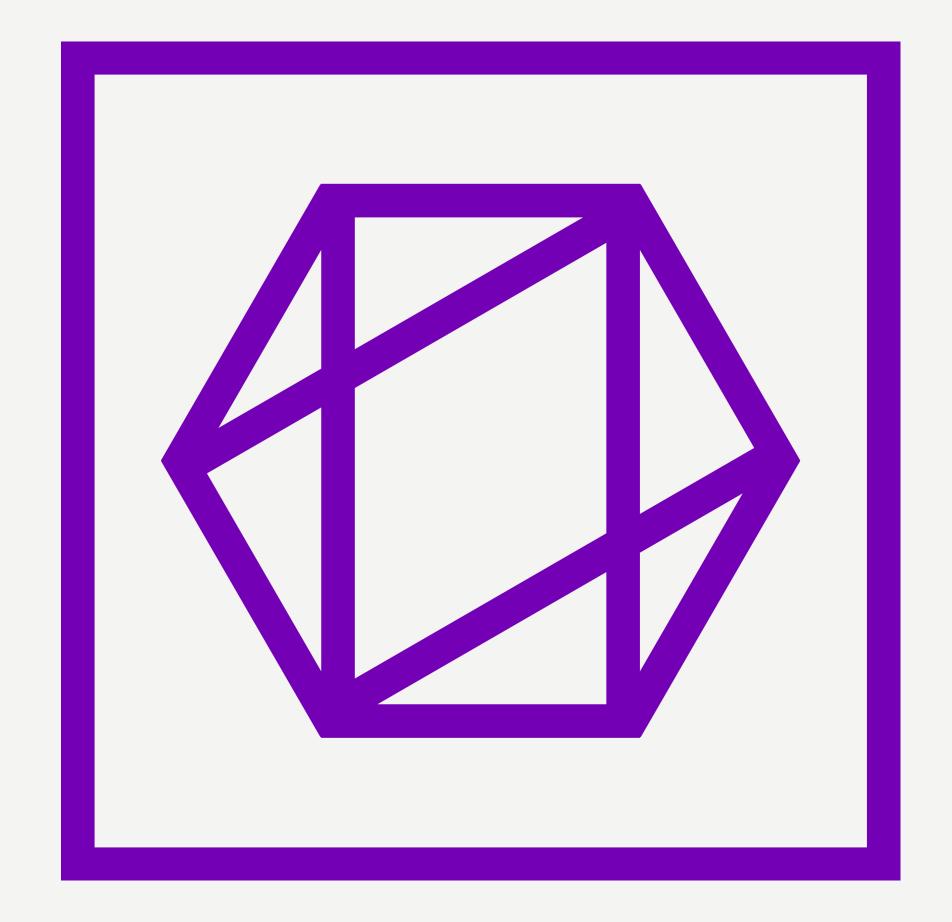

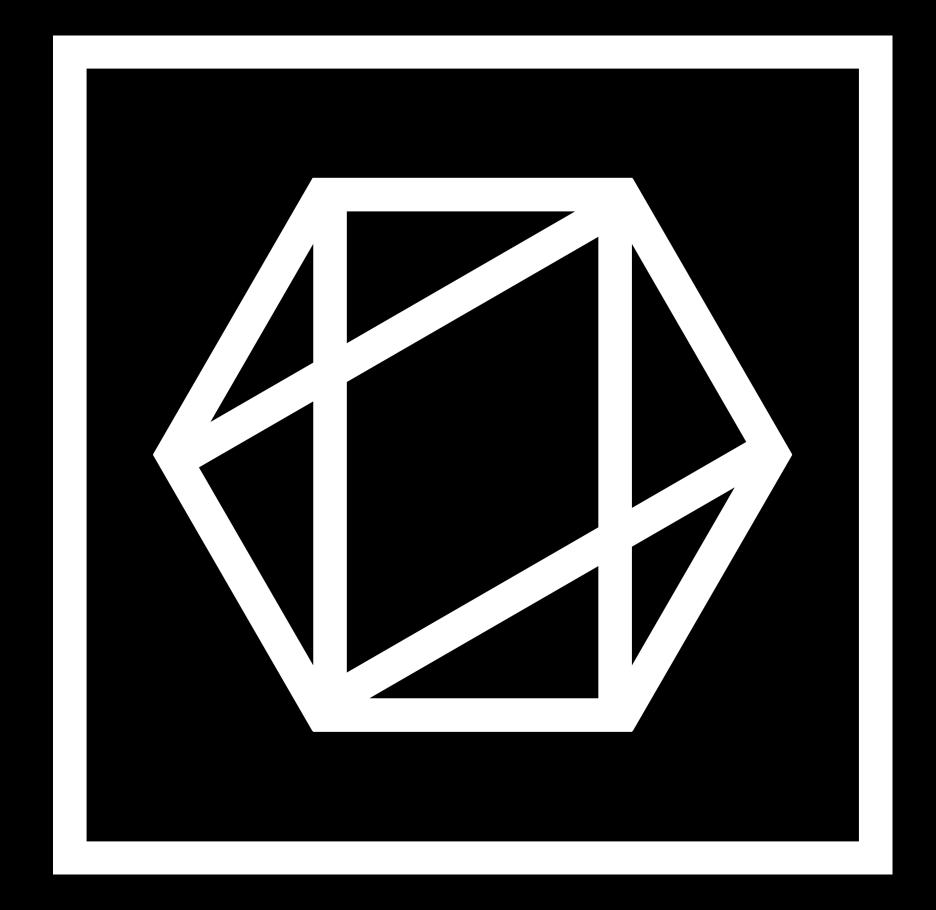
Primary Logo

Also called as the "Diamond". It represents the ultimate composition of all types of knowledge and the endless possibilities the platform meant to provide to educators. Having a border helps keeping the distance between other visual elements. A white stroke might be used for better visibility.



Primary Logo

On darker backgrounds, the pure white version of the diamond should be used.



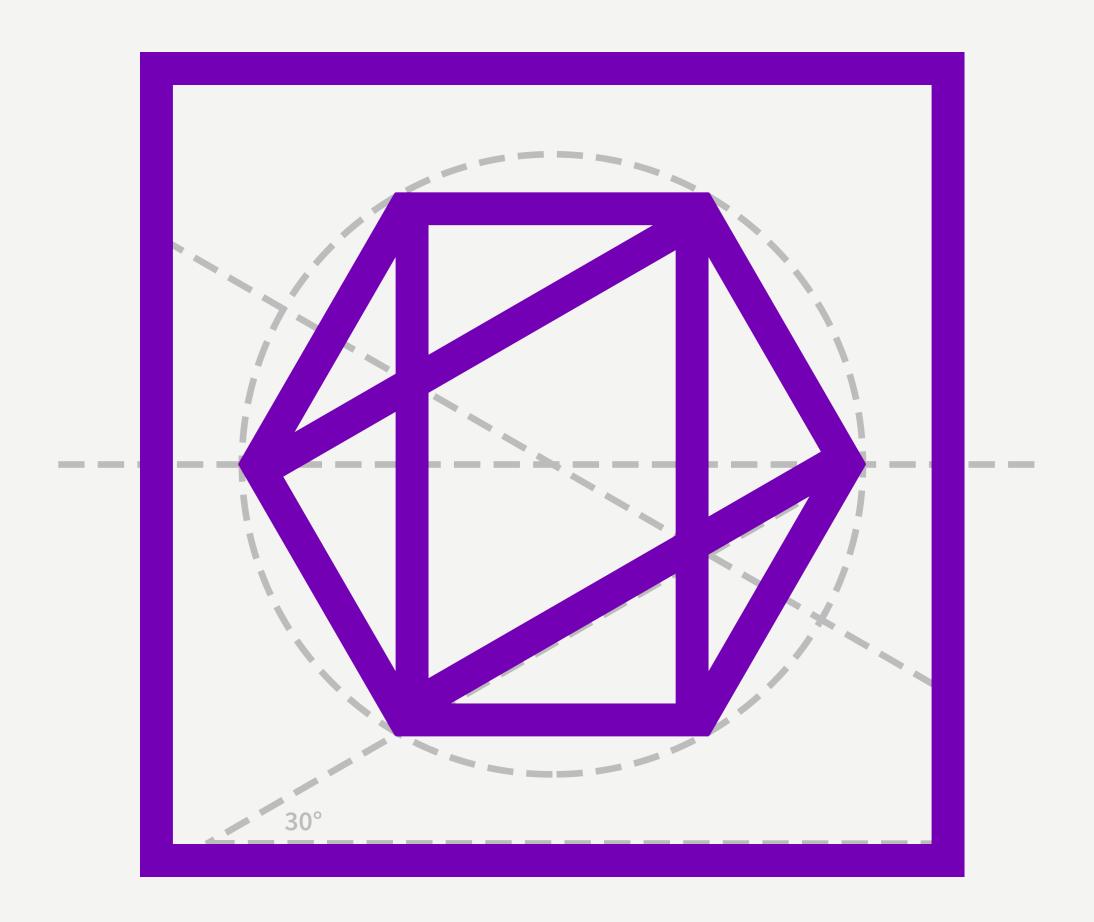
Secondary Logo

Sometimes the logo needs to appear in rounded boxes or inside oval boxes. Bordering lines would make this look bad, so an alternative display is preferred in these cases.



The Logo Construction

The Diamond itself is a **regular hexagon with two pairs of parallel diagonals** connected. The two
other diagonals are purposefully missing!

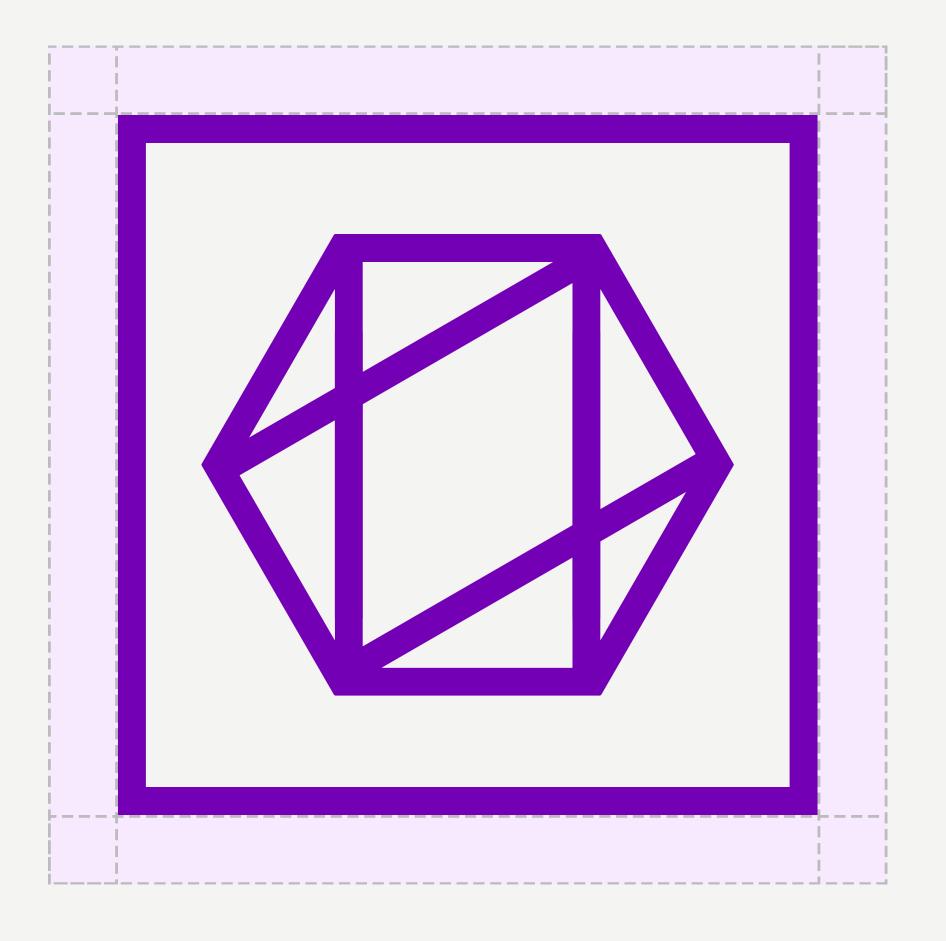
The Logo Text

The Diamond is ofter put together with the EduBase logo text to form the final Logo together. This text might have a white stroke just like the Primary Logo if it enhances visibility. EDU is SemiBold, while BASE is ExtraLight and uses the main font type, Titillium Web.

Safe Zone

You must keep some space around the Logos and the Logo Text as well. There is no solid value, nor in pixels, nor in percentage of size, but it needs to be distinctable from the environment it is embedded into.

Typography

Primary Typeface

This is for titles, the Logo Text and important parts of texts. It should not be overused!

This font is rarely used in smaller sizes and regular and bolder weights as well. Prefer Light and ExtraLight where possible, and try to avoid Italic styles.

Typography Secondary Typeface

This font is for contents and common parts of texts. The website uses this font for displaying all texts except for titles and special sections. Prefer Regular and Bold font weights in most cases, Italic styles are acceptable.
